"This interdisciplinary project consisting of 120 instructional hours aims to help first-year baccalaureate students understand the common values of the EU by analysing sustainability from scientific, economic, and social perspectives.

By integrating subjects such as Biology and Geology, Contemporary World History, Geography, Economics, and English, the project promotes a cooperative and bilingual approach. Over the course of three academic years, students will explore EU environmental policies, the impact of climate change, and the role of sustainable economy in Europe's future.

Through active methodologies like Project-Based Learning, students will work in teams to design a European Sustainable City, create a campaign to raise awareness about responsible consumption, and participate in a simulation of a European climate summit, proposing innovative solutions to EU environmental challenges, and applying scientific, economic, and social knowledge."
